

ATTENDANCE POLICY

(The following policy applies to each Concert Set)

- 1. You are expected to attend all rehearsals and concerts.
- 2. You are responsible for notifying your Section Leader in advance of any absence.
- 3. You may miss one rehearsal in a Concert Set. A second absence may be granted at the discretion of the Section Leader. Participation in rehearsal retreats may make up for an additional absence.
- 4. If more absences are necessary, you and your Section Leader will need to determine if you are sufficiently prepared to sing at the concert. If not, you will be put on leave for that Concert Set. You may resume participation for the next Concert Set.
- 5. Absences from a concert week rehearsal must be cleared with the Artistic Director in advance to remain eligible to sing the concert. If you anticipate missing a performance, you must discuss your absence with your Section Leader and the Artistic Director as soon as possible.
- 6. You are responsible for obtaining all information provided during your absence before the next rehearsal (e.g., music markings/notations, change in rehearsal times). We make every effort to record and post our rehearsals on our members page of the website, so please take advantage of this resource.
- 7. Courtesy to the Artistic Director and to the Chorale membership requires promptness at rehearsals. Please explain tardiness or early departure to your Section Leader. Section Leaders will monitor the amount of rehearsal time missed. Arrival or departure at break will be counted as one-half (1/2) absence.
